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About the Instructor:

My name is Michelle East and I have taught 2nd grade- HS art teacher at Summit Christian Academy for 10 years. I have been teaching the afterschool art enrichment class for 3 years now and have previously taught three summer Art Camps. I am also a professional artist and have won several national awards for my artwork. My personal art website is www.MichelleEastArt.com

Enrichment Art Class Objective:

The afterschool art class is a 10 week session where we create artwork each week based on different mediums (painting, drawing, clay, mixed media, etc.) and different styles of art. Most of the projects take 2-3 classes-so we should complete 5-6 total projects over the session. Art history & the elements and principles of art are incorporated into the lessons whenever possible. The class is intended to be a fun art experience for the children, so we experiment with art supplies to create unique pieces of art. They will strengthen skills learned in the classroom as well as learn new art techniques.

Tuition:

Payment will be due (paid in full) at the beginning of the 10 week session. Classes will last one hour and 10 minutes long. *Please make payment payable to Michelle East.* If there is financial hardship that makes it difficult to pay monthly, please let me know and other arrangements may be made if needed. There will be an additional \$35 fee for returned checks.

If you choose to cancel your enrollment in the class, I must know by the second week of class. I will then refund 80% of the tuition fee back to you. After two weeks all supplies have been purchased for the 10-week class & therefore tuition will not be refunded.

Missed Lessons:

There will be no refunds for missed classes. The 10 week session is designed with some extra time for make-up artwork. If possible, PLEASE AVOID scheduling doctor/dental, orthodontist, and other similar appointments during the art class time. Interruption of the weekly progress inhibits a student from learning and growing efficiently.

I am very much looking forward to creating art with your child this session, and I will do all that I can to help them reach their full artistic potential!
